How do I reserve a time and place for an event at the Jesuit Retreat House?

- **1st step** – Call or email us with details of your event/retreat and the number of people you expect.
- **2nd step** – We will let you know if we can accommodate your request, and verify the cost. Events/retreats need to be booked, and a down payment made, at least one month prior to date.
- **3rd step** – Once the date and details are agreed upon, we ask for 25% down on the minimum payment required so that the dates/place can be reserved.
- **4th step** - Keep us posted on any change in plans so we can be ready for you.
- **Final step** – Come and enjoy!

Hospitality Services

On Lake Winnebago

Meetings*

Tuesdays or Wednesdays

Morning \$25/person

Hot breakfast starts the day, and your meeting, to be held in Loyola Dining Room & Lounge.
Time: Four hours, before noon. Minimum: \$500.

Business Only \$20/person

Get down to business, morning or afternoon, in a room that fits your needs. Beverages & snacks. Time: Three hours. Minimum: \$200.

Mid-Day \$25/person

Lunch in Loyola Dining Room, noon to 1 p.m., with meeting times before and/or after lunch.
Time: Four hours. Minimum: \$500.

Evening \$30/person

Dinner in Loyola Dining Room with meeting to follow in a room that fits your group's needs.
Time: Four hours. Minimum: \$600.

Half-Day \$50 OR \$55/person

Breakfast and lunch OR lunch and dinner in Loyola Dining Room, depending on what half of the day you choose. Meetings in-between in a room that fits the needs and size of your group.
Time: Six OR Eight hours. Minimum: \$1,000.

** Ask about availability of Mass or prayer services for an additional offering when you gather at the Jesuit Retreat House.*

Day of Recollection

Tuesdays or Wednesdays

One-Day, Hosted \$50/person

Group brings presenters, clergy, and content. Access to St. Ignatius Chapel, Loyola Lounge and Dining Room, LaStorta Conference Room, and adjacent areas. Lunch from noon to 1 p.m., beverages & snacks available throughout day.
Time: Eight hours. Minimum: \$1,000.

One-Day, Offered \$75/person

Jesuit Retreat House provides the presenters, clergy, content. Access to St. Ignatius Chapel, Loyola Lounge and Dining Room, LaStorta Conference Room, and adjacent areas. Lunch, noon to 1 p.m., beverages & snacks available.
Time: Eight hours. Minimum: \$1,500.

Overnight Retreats

Mondays and/or Tuesdays

Minimum: 20 retreatants

One Night \$125/person

Group brings presenters, clergy, and content. Access to St. Ignatius Chapel, Loyola Lounge and Dining Room, LaStorta Conference Room, Manresa Residential Wing, and adjacent areas. All meals provided, and beverages & snacks.
Arrive: 3 p.m. 1st day, Depart: 3 p.m. last day.

Two Nights \$250/person



Private Retreats

Individual or Small Group

Campion Hermitage \$75/night/person

Located on the retreat grounds, this two-story farmhouse has six bedrooms, kitchen, sitting area, dining room, a three-quarters bathroom on the 1st floor and half-bath on the 2nd floor.

Available for individual or small-group retreats, the house has a kitchen, equipped with stove, microwave, refrigerator, for preparing food.

An individual retreatant, if not part of a group, will be alone in the house so as to respect their privacy and the silence of their retreat.

Small groups on retreat are asked to respect the silence of the retreat house grounds so as not to disturb other retreatants.

If you are interested in a spiritual director for your retreat, a list of possible spiritual directors will be provided so you can arrange frequency and cost yourself.

Eucharist may be celebrated with the Jesuit community if retreats are not being held, and with the retreatants during times of retreat.
